

## CPD Framework leading to a BSc (Hons) in Applied Health Sciences Knowledge and Practice APPS3103

The module seeks to explore the interdependent relationship between knowledge and professional practice.

While the dynamic inter-relationship and inter-dependence of this dualism is acknowledged, the forms and characteristics of such a relationship are issues for debate.

The module is premised upon the belief that the act of examination and review of the preconceptions of knowledge within professional practice will inform critical consideration. This will therefore, generate new insights and personal perspectives, thus enhancing evidence based care delivery.

### Assessments

#### Essay – 3,000 words (70%)

A critical exploration of an aspect of professional practice, with reference to a range of ways of knowing, explored during the module.

#### Presentation (30%)

A 15 minute presentation to promote discussion of the ways of knowing contained in an item of printed material.
