

## CPD Framework leading to a BSc (Hons) in Applied Health Sciences Holistic Health Assessment – The Adult Client APPS3135

All clinical interactions require health care professionals to have at their disposal a range of physical assessment, interview and evaluation skills. Whilst it is recognised that many clinical staff already possess many of these skills, this module is designed to support their prior knowledge of anatomy, physiology and pathophysiology, which will facilitate and enhance further development of health assessment skills in a patient focused holistic way. This module will support clinical staff, particularly nurses as they expand their role in the field of holistic health and physical assessment.

### Assessments

The summative assessment is divided into 3 parts:

#### Part 1

Professional Portfolio providing evidence and written critical reflection concerning the practitioner's achievement of set clinical competencies and learning outcomes.

#### Part 2

A 5 station Observed Structured Clinical Examination that assesses clinical skills in a simulated setting.

#### Part 3

Successful completion of clinical competencies that have been designed in line with the Knowledge and Skills Framework and Skills for Health Framework.
