Transport:

Getting to **Worcester from Heathrow** airport:

take the RailAir coach (www.railair.com) directly from your terminal to Reading station. There are direct trains from Reading to Worcester (see <http://www.nationalrail.co.uk/> for the schedule). Make sure that you travel to **Worcester Foregate Street** station, which is the station in the city centre - the City campus is a 7-8 minute walk from here. Worcester Shrub Hill is on the edge of the city centre – it will take around 20- 25 minutes to walk from this station to the City campus. Direct trains **from London to Worcester** depart from Paddington Station.

Delegates travelling **by car** are able to park their vehicle at the Riverside car park, which is a five-minute walk from the City Campus. There is only disabled parking on the City Campus.
