### Home to the Business School

The Georgian building where the British Medical Association was founded has been one of Worcester's most important buildings for over 200 years.

Reopened in September 2010 as [Worcester Business School's](#), the restored Infirmary is a focal point for excellent education, a centre for the arts, a resource for businesses and a dramatic fusion of old and new architecture.

The Business School reflects a real-world business environment with open-plan, multi-directional learning spaces, interconnected with boardroom, meeting rooms, staff offices and reception area. The building provides high-tech computer suites, a purpose built entertainment room, social learning spaces where you can meet, study, chat with your fellow students and access learning technologies. There is also a 24/7 internet cafe, on-site leisure facilities including a well-being centre complete with gym and therapy and treatment rooms.
