Schedule of Delegation

The [Schedule of Delegation](#) was last reviewed by the Board at its meeting held on 3rd July 2017. It is reviewed on at least an annual basis.

The Schedule was developed in light of sector best practice guidelines (provided by the Committee of University Chairman (CUC)) and with reference to the University's Instrument and Articles of Government. The latter constitute the overriding authority, should there be any contradiction, and the Articles shall be interpreted in such a manner as not to conflict with the Instrument.
