We are now taking applications from interested businesses able to offer a one-year paid work placement and high calibre graduates alike. Applications from first-degree graduates from all backgrounds and disciplines who hold, or are predicted to achieve, at least a 2:1 degree or higher, may apply to undertake a 2-year part-time postgraduate programme leading to an Executive MBA in Leadership and Management delivered at [Worcester Business School](#).
