- [Animal Biology BSc \(Hons\)](#)

The study of animal biology is becoming increasingly important to our understanding of significant aspects of the environment, agriculture and the wider economy.

- [Human Nutrition BSc \(Hons\)](#)

This Human Nutrition programme offers you the opportunity to explore the connections between food constituents, diet and health, with an emphasis on practical experience and real life scenarios.

- [Arboriculture BSc \(Hons\)/FdSc](#)

This new course is ideal for those who wish to become arboriculturists or tree surgeons and have a head for heights.

- [Archaeology and Heritage Studies BA \(Hons\)](#)

This hands-on course introduces you to the artefacts, monuments, people and landscapes that represent the remains of past cultures.

- [Archaeology and Landscape Studies BSc \(Hons\)](#)

This degree provides an integrated, multidisciplinary approach to studying the landscape and the people who have inhabited and shaped it.

- [Biochemistry BSc \(Hons\)](#)

Biochemistry lies at the very heart of biology and investigates the interaction of molecules to explain the fundamentals of life, where a small change in a single molecule can have a dramatic effect on an entire organism. Biochemistry lies at the very heart

- [Biology BSc \(Hons\)](#)

Part of the wider biological sciences programme, the central themes of this course are the impact of biology on society and the effects of human influences on the environment.

- [Conservation Ecology BSc \(Hons\)](#)

Environmental Science at Worcester explores the theory and scientific explanations to allow a full understanding of environmental issues.

With a hands-on approach, this course brings theory to life, and will develop your intellectual, practical and social skills relevant to both forensic and general biological careers.
