

- Why did you include some literature and omit others? (only include literature that serves a purpose)
- Have you emphasised recent developments?
- Have you included primary and secondary sources?
- Is all of the literature relevant?
- Is your bibliographic data complete?
- Have you organised your material, and is your organisation logical? (could organise by theme, or separate methodology from theme/subject)
- Does detail reflect significance? (if it's important you should have a lot to write about, less important work may require a few lines or just a quick reference)
- Have you been critical regarding design and methodology? (Would they have got different results with different methodology? Was it ethical? How big was the sample size?)
- Have you indicated inconclusive or contradictory material?
- Have you indicated the relevance for all of your sections?
- Has your literature review assisted the reader in understanding the relevance/importance of your topic?
