main my tale









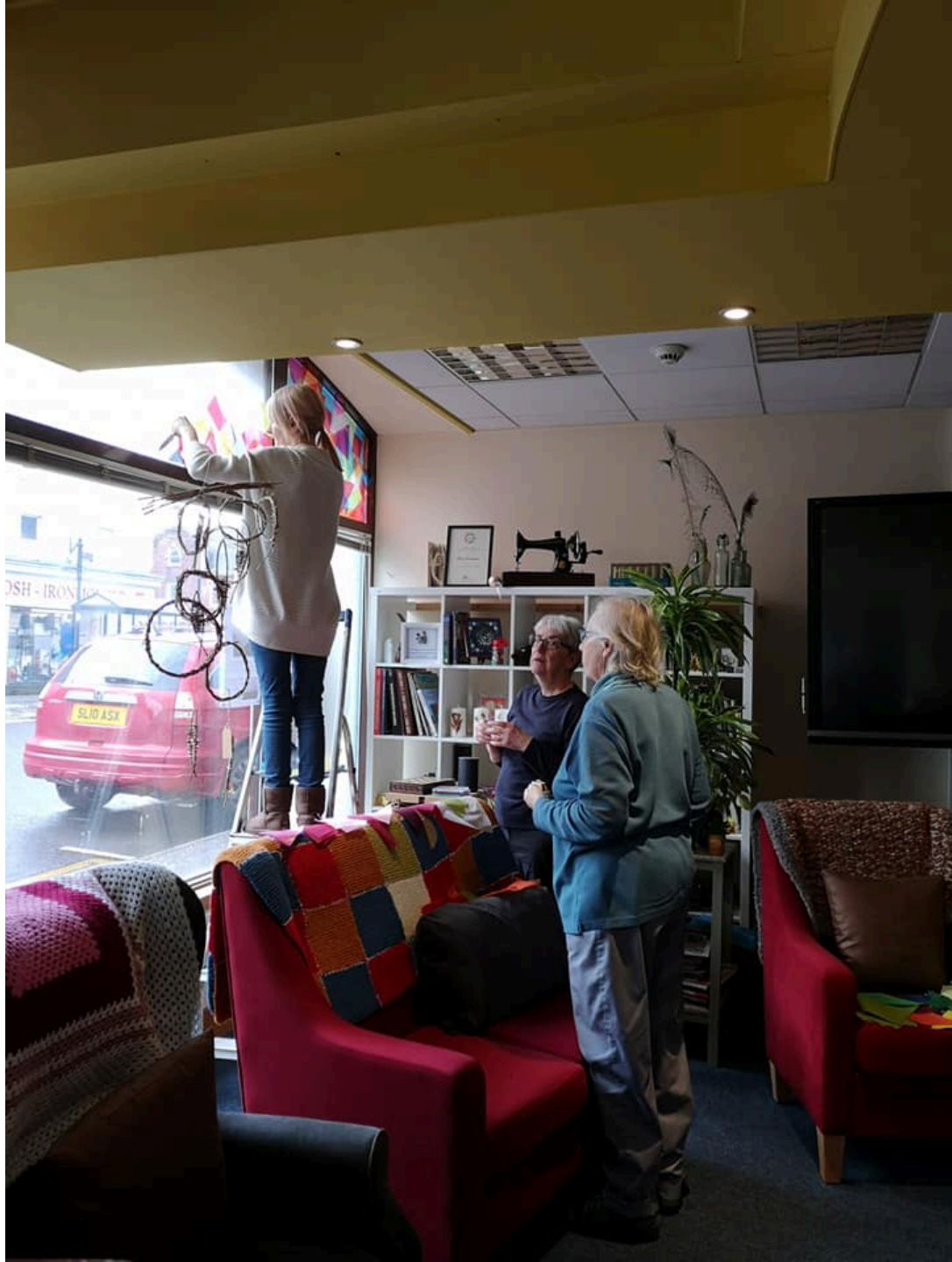
