

Working with people with dementia – applying the Admiral Nursing Competency Framework

MSAP4110

This module will enable Admiral Nurses from a variety of work settings and roles to engage with their Admiral Nurse Competency Framework through an academic module.

Study will be through a blended approach using 4 face to face study days and 2 distance learning days using action learning, includes tutorial support and specialist speakers, on-line resources and self-directed study.

You will acquire the ability to critically engage with the Admiral Nurse Competency Framework, and to both reflect upon and evaluate your own professional role in order to further enhance your professional practice.

You will gain a good introductory start to Pebblepad and how this can be used to develop your portfolio and Pebblepad will be available to you within your practice.
