Pay for what you need.

Our typical contracts for undergraduate students are only 40 weeks, compared to many private sector contracts of 52 weeks. If your course requires you to be here longer than 40 weeks, your contract will be issued for an appropriate length of time to your course.

That's why all University-managed accommodation at the University of Worcester operates on-site maintenance as well as 24-hour security. Day or night, our friendly staff are here to help.

There are no extra charges for gas, electricity or water usage – these are all covered by your accommodation costs. All Halls of Residence also benefit from free Wi-Fi internet access, contents insurance and regular cleaning of communal areas, regardless of which accommodation you choose.

Finding the right student accommodation is key to your university experience. Whichever University of Worcester accommodation you live in, you'll enjoy many benefits.

You can choose from several types of high-quality accommodation at Worcester, much of it recently built or renovated, with options to suit a variety of budgets and needs. All rooms are fully furnished and are nonsmoking. The University is registered with the Student Accommodation Code (SAC) and more details can be found on www.thesac.org.uk.

No matter which option you choose, you can take advantage of inclusive utility bills, free internet and free gym membership. Key facilities, such as a laundrette, shop, cafés and a canteen, can all be found on campus so it's easy to find your feet and settle into student life.

Our University-managed accommodation includes our on-campus Halls of Residence, which are all within easy walking distance of where you'll be studying and of the city centre.

This guide gives you more details on all our Halls of Residence so that you can decide which one is right for you.

Once you're settled, you can stay in your room for the duration of your contract, including over the Christmas and Easter holidays. If you wish, we can also help you stay in Halls over the summer.

You're guaranteed a place in our accommodation.

If you're a first-year undergraduate applicant and you accept an offer from us, make Worcester your firm choice on UCAS and apply for accommodation by 4th June 2025, you are guaranteed a place in our University-managed accommodation.

Postgraduate students are able to apply for any of our Halls of Residence, and will be housed with other postgraduate students wherever possible. Postgraduate Halls are exclusively for postgraduate students.

Postgraduate applicants who apply for accommodation by 4th June 2025 are also guaranteed a place in our University-managed accommodation.

Preferences are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis, so the earlier you apply, the better chance you have of securing your preferred choice.

All students in our University-managed accommodation are eligible for free gym membership. Our fully-equipped gym is based on Severn Campus, within easy walking distance of our Halls, making it easy to work out around your schedule.

These Halls are brilliant options for keeping costs down. Traditional Halls offer a total of 62 rooms.

A place of your own

Your room has a bed, a wardrobe and a desk study space, as well as noticeboards on the wall. The majority of rooms have a sink. 56 of the 62 rooms have their own study spaces; 6 rooms have shared study spaces.





The accessible rooms also have their own accessible wet room and an associated carer's room adjacent, which features a self-contained kitchenette, including a two-ring induction hob.






