We understand that you currently do not hold the required English qualification for your course and are interested in sitting the English Equivalency test offered at this University.

- Each test costs £30 (**non-refundable**) and will last for 2 hours.
- Each test is at an intermediate difficulty and features some questions from both higher and lower papers.
- Please note that candidates are allowed a **maximum** of 2 attempts as each test. If you are unsuccessful after 2 attempts candidates are advised to enrol on a GCSE course.

The University **does not** provide tuition or exam guidance, this is the candidate's responsibility. We recommend that you revise sufficiently before sitting the test, especially if you have not attempted GCSE style questions for a while.

Practice test papers are provided but if you need further practice GCSE exam papers can be downloaded from the internet (e.g. BBC Bitesize website). We also recommend you purchase of a suitable GCSE English revision guide (e.g. the Letts Study Guide) and that you look for tuition where necessary.

Please allow a **minimum** of 2 weeks for the test to be marked and for the results to be announced. This can take longer for July / August tests due to availability of tutors.

Ensure you book early as places are limited to a maximum of 5 applicants per exam session and please return the form at least 4 working days before the test date. We reserve the right to refuse entry to the exam if we have not had confirmation prior to this.

These tests are designed to meet the NCTL requirements that all entrants to Teacher Training courses have achieved a standard equivalent to a Grade C/4 at GCSE. The tests are not subject to national validation in the same way as GCSEs so they **may not** be acceptable at other Higher Education Institutions and students who pass these tests are **not** entitled to claim that they have a GCSE in these subjects.
