

Parking in an unmarked car park

Whilst parking at the University of Worcester on occasion you may be required to park in an unmarked car park.

Knowing how to park without any lines can be difficult but there's some useful tips on what to do that will help you out.

Vehicles should aim to create lines much like in any car park with marked bays. Vehicles should park a single line alongside the boundary of the car park leaving an access route from the entrance until the line is full.

A space should then be left about the length of a car behind this first line where another can now be started in much the same way. Once this line is full a second should be started directly behind as close to the vehicle in front as you can.

Once this second line has filled another car length space should be left behind and another new double line started.

Parking in this way ensures the maximum number of vehicles can park on an unmarked car park and maintains access routes so that everyone is able to leave at their own convenience.

Please refer to the below image as an example of how this should be achieved.

Please park considerately and sensibly with consideration of other parked vehicles and DO NOT block access routes or other vehicles in.
