Content includes:

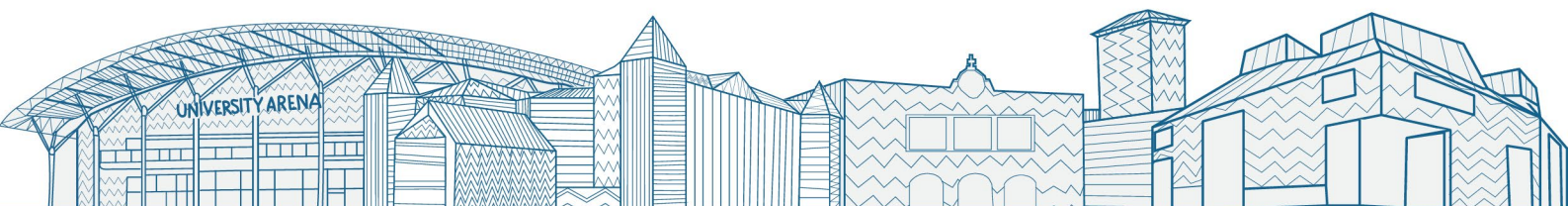
- Principles and theories of coaching, leadership and role modelling
