

# Return to Nursing Practice

## BNSA3050

### Funding is available for this module

This module is designed for NMC nurse registrants whose registration has lapsed or those unable to meet revalidation requirements, to return to, or remain on the NMC register as a Registered Nurse. The module will support students to become confident, competent, compassionate, autonomous and accountable professionals who are fit for purpose and can practice in accordance with the NMC Code (2018).

This module can be taken as a stand alone level 6 module with 15 credits awarded; it can also be used as a module towards the Nursing Studies BSc(Hons) award. If taken as a stand alone module there is no university award attached to this.

### Assessment:

1500 word critical reflection on practice during the clinical placement.

The practice element of the module requires a minimum of 250 hours in practice assessed by a practice assessor. This assessment will take place supported by the development and use of a Practice Assessment Document.

### Entry Criteria:

The criteria for admission to this course will be that the student has previously been registered on part 1 or 2 of the NMC register and whose name has never been removed from the register.
