Negotiated Learning for Advanced Clinical Practice MACP4008

This module provides an opportunity to pursue a personal or professional interest relevant to advanced clinical practice and the student's own discipline and work area. With the support of a named supervisor the student will develop their own learning outcomes, set an assessment task and provide a suggested bibliography. All aspects must be approved by the module leader. With guidance the students can use this module to explore an area which will further their own professional development in advanced clinical practice and achieve level 7 credits.

Students will be supported by their supervisor in writing their module contract and planning their learning outcomes which should be congruent with the course learning outcomes and the QAA (2010) Master's Degree Characteristics.

Students are required to access and work with material within their own specific area of interest relating specifically to advanced clinical practice capabilities, and the learning outcomes of the programme. The types of learning that would be negotiated could include for example, therapeutic interventions, knowledge and development of skills and knowledge linked to reviewing medicines, non-medicinal products and treatments.
