Helen completed a BSc (2:1) in Animal and Plant Science at the University of Newcastle followed by an MSc (Distinction) in Environmental Archaeology at the University of Sheffield. She specialised in archaeobotany and worked for 6 years as an archaeobotanist for the Universities of Sheffield, Nottingham and Leicester.

The research projects Helen worked on took her to Syria, Bulgaria, Greece and Egypt during this time (along with a number of co-publications). She also completed a PG Cert in Learning and Teaching and taught on some archaeobotany and research methods modules at both Sheffield and Leicester Universities.

Responsibilities

As Head of Doctoral Services, Helen has oversight of all research degree students, supervisors and programmes at the University and responsibility for the development and enhancement of all associated regulations and procedures associated with these programmes along with the development of new programmes.
