Computers



There are approximately1500 computers on campus which account for at least 20% of the University's energy use. All student PCs in Peirson and open access areas are fitted with Powersave and this energy-saving facility is being rolled out to all staff PCs during 2009/10.

Fully turn off your PC at the mains socket at the end of the working day

Don't leave your PC modem or monitor on overnight - turning it off at the end of the working day will save almost 70 percent of the electricity used in a typical working week compared to leaving it on. It's also important to turn your computer off at the mains switch at weekends and when you go on leave.

Did you know?

If left on permanently, a single PC and screen will cost around £100 a year to run and emits 450 kg of CO² which is enough to fill 3 double-decker buses.
