Doing Business in Europe – Sustainable Marketing

This course focuses on topics related to international business and global marketing in specific EU-countries. You will acquire intercultural skills and will learn more about the Eurozone, social enterprises and sales techniques for doing business in Europe. In groups, you will design a marketing campaign plan and present it to the CEO of Philips at their headquarters in Amsterdam. Excursions, city trips and a visit to a Dutch isle are included in the programme.

Doing Business in Europe – International Communication

The course focuses on diving into intercultural issues in international communication, and learning and practicing how to communicate effectively across cultures. You will explore concepts such as culture shock, cultural values and intercultural competences and will train your skills individually and in groups. This course is structured in such a way that the theory learned is put into practice by working on assignments in a project and group setting.
