## Campus Sites

The University has three main sites: St John's Campus, City Campus and Severn Campus.

## Parking

## Road

Worcester is just off the M5 motorway and is accessible from Junctions 6 and 7. Under normal traffic conditions, all of our campuses can be reached in 15-20 minutes from Junction 7. Free parking is available at all campuses.

## Public transport

Worcester Foregate Street train station is situated in the city centre and is a 25-30 minute walk from St John's Campus (or 5 minutes by taxi), or just a 5-minute walk from City Campus.

The number 31A bus connects the St John's Campus to the Worcester Bus Station in the City Centre

## Walking

City Campus is a 25 minute walk from St John's Campus, with the Severn Campus situated between the two.
