HOW TO FIND THE ROOMS AT OUR OPEN DAY

All activities available on your visit will indicate a room location. To help you identify where to go, we have included the below guide:

The first 2 symbols of the room number refer to the building (for example PN - Peirson building).

Next is the floor (for example EE G089 - G being the ground floor).

Finally the room number (for example EE G020 - 020 is the room number).

There are also campus maps on pages 8 and 9 to help guide you on your day.

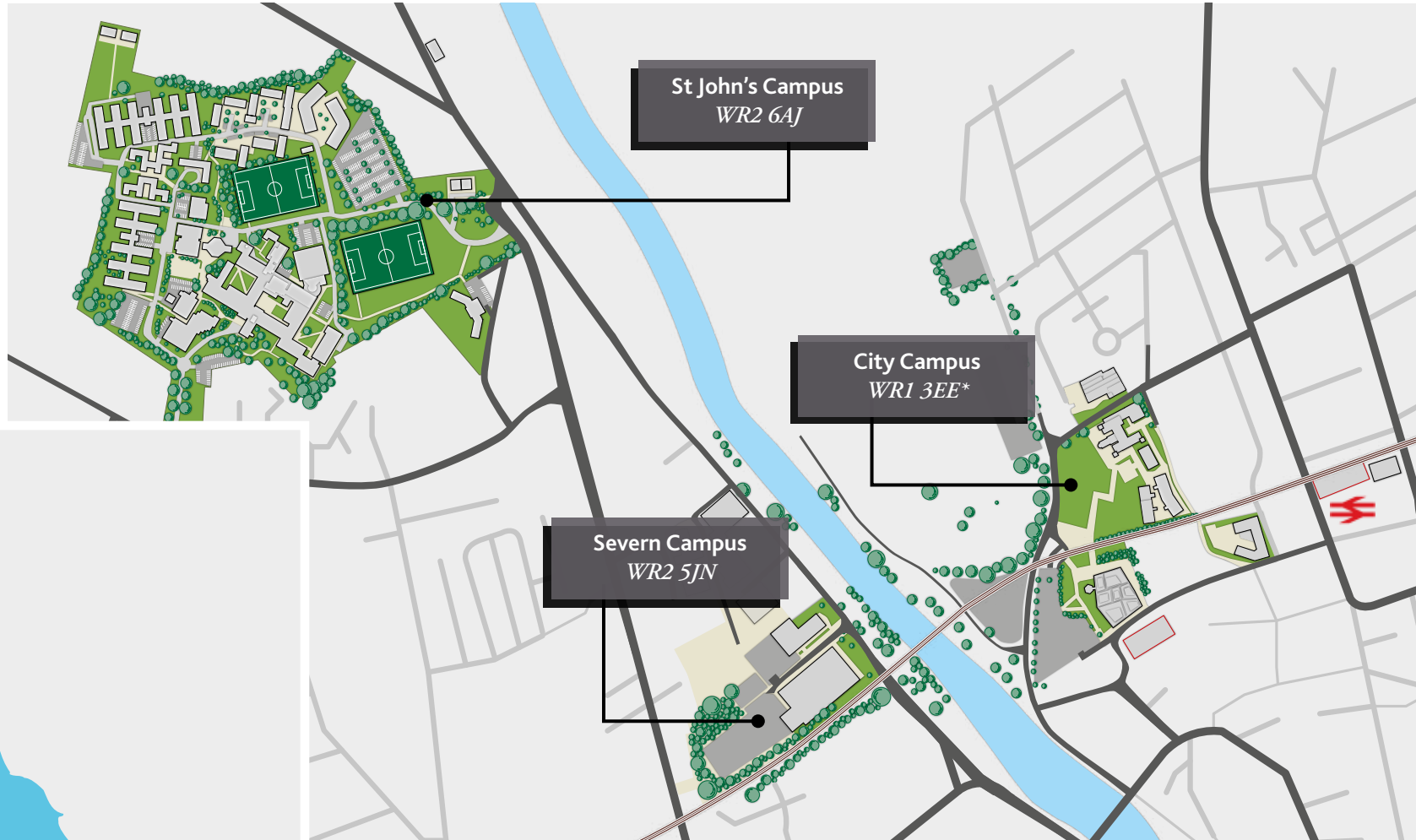

HOW TO FIND US

The University has three main sites: St John's Campus, City Campus and Severn Campus.

The St John's and City Campus are a pleasant 20-minute walk from each other, with the Severn Campus conveniently situated between the two.



ROAD

Worcester is just off the M5 motorway and is accessible from Junctions 6 and 7. Under normal traffic conditions, all University campuses can be reached in 15-20 minutes from Junction 7. The University is clearly signposted once you come off at Junction 7.

TRAIN

Worcester has two train stations. Worcester Foregate Street is situated in the city centre and is a 25-30 minute walk from the University or 5 minutes by taxi.

Worcester Shrub Hill is a 40-45 minute walk from the University or 10 minutes by taxi.

BUS

The number 31A bus, operated by First Travel, connects the St John's Campus to the city centre bus station and to City Campus. The bus stops are located outside the Students' Union building and near Severn Gate on the St John's Campus.

WHERE TO GO

Parking is free at all of our campuses on the day. For free parking at our City Campus, head to the Moors car park (WR1 3EE) or our Jenny Lind car park (WR1 3BZ).

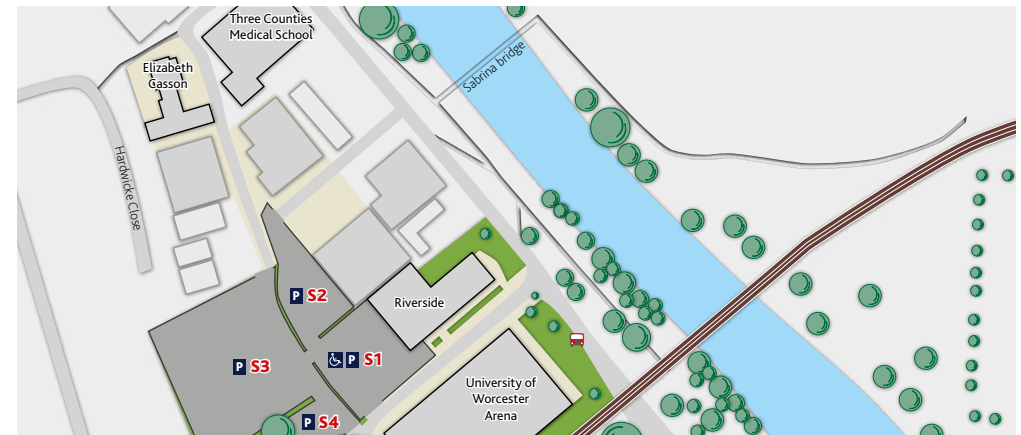

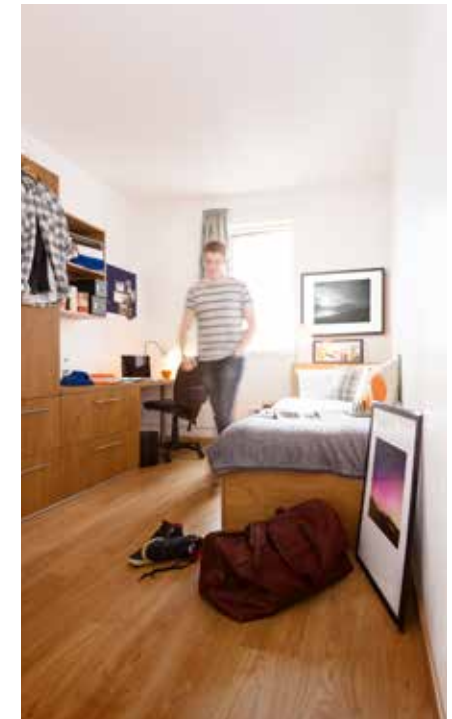

VOLUNTEERING AND FUNDRAISING

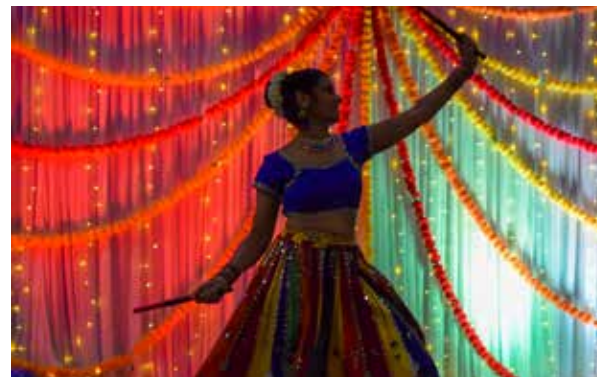

The purpose-built courtroom in our Jenny Lind Building features benches for judges, barristers, defendants, witnesses and even members of the press, just like a working court. There is also a jury room next door to simulate the real court experience, and a number of seminar rooms.

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TAKE A LOOK AROUND

Visit the Sheila Scott Building, which is home to our skills and simulation centre. Our high specification clinical skills laboratories simulate 'real life' situations, allowing you to experience, develop and learn practical skills before going out to practice placements. Our remote-control centre enables lecturers to programme and control the manikins to simulate illness, effects of nursing interventions and treatments. The video recording equipment allows you to review and reflect on your abilities, and to share this with other students.

You can also visit the relevant teaching rooms in Ability House, in which the concept of environmental design ranges from removal of steps and the use of durable floor covering to allow maneuverability for wheelchairs and people using wheeled walking frames, to the installation of ceiling track hoist systems to allow for safe transfers from a seated position and transfer to another location, such as a bed, a seat or a bathtub.

These outstanding facilities provide students with the space to safely practice nursing and midwifery interventions.

Our St John's Campus is home to our Motion and Performance Centre and Human Performance Labs, which comprise a suite of laboratories supporting the study of physiology and biomechanics. As well as this, St John's Campus holds our Sports Hall, which has 6 courts, a gymnasium hall and an outdoor full size 3G AstroTurf.

You will be taken on a tour of our University Arena, which is an indoor 2000-seat/12 court sports venue, supported by a conference suite and break-out rooms.

The tour will also include a visit to the Riverside Building, which holds 2 courts, a sports therapy lab, a performance analysis suite and a fully air-conditioned fitness suite.

The Medicine MBChB is open for International and a small number of Home graduate applicants with a 2:1 degree or above or a 2:2 with a masters.

The MBChB programme is a 4 year graduate entry medical degree that emphasises early patient contact, a fully integrated curriculum and highlights problem-based learning. We will be available at the open day to talk about the entry requirements and your opportunities to train as a doctor in the Three Counties.

VISIT THE ADMISSIONS AND FINANCE TEAMS

Our Admissions and Finance teams will be available at Firstpoint at our St John's campus from 10:00 until 14:00 on the day to chat through any questions you may have about entry requirements or financial support.

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The creation of the Three Counties Medical School at the University of Worcester opens up the opportunity for you to train to be a medical doctor within the region.

The facility will include a specialised anatomy skills room using high-fidelity models for visualisation of anatomy, pathology and physiology; a simulated GP surgery with a suite of consultation rooms; technology for viewing and feedback space; and easily dividable units for Objective Structured Clinical Examinations.

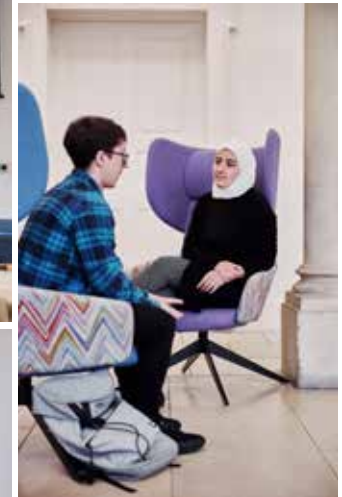
